

STUDENT PARTICIPATION

The following five documents are included for your examination.

Activity Program – Participants Report – Summary 2000-01

This spreadsheet contains 9-12 athletic information and 10-12 activity information. The report is circulated to activity sponsors who are asked to fill out the form for their activity and submit it to Jim O’Dea who then forwards it to the LRC.

Since the report totals 3459 participants, an individual student can and is counted multiple times within the report. For example, to be eligible for thespians, a student must be active in drama. The 27 students listed in thespians would also be listed among the 110 students listed in drama. An individual student can likewise participate in more than one sport during the school year.

Additionally, an individual student can and is counted multiple times within a single activity. For example, vocal music participation is listed as 525. During the school year 321 students were enrolled in vocal music and eligible to participate in the extra activities. Another example is in the band total of 143. This is not the classroom enrollment, but rather a count of students who are eligible from the classroom enrollment and who did participate in extra band activities like All State tryouts, Perry Band Olympics, state solo contest, etc.

January 30, 2002 – PAA Oral Survey

PAA leaders read the questions to the students and then counted the student’s raised hands. Both the questions utilized and the survey results are enclosed.

April 1, 2002 – Participation Summary for VHS & VSW for the School Board

Individual student names were entered for 77 activities and athletics at Valley and 43 activities and athletics at Southwoods. Name duplications were consolidated and the number of individual students in 0 to 14 activities was detailed.

Athletic and activity rosters were used for Valley Southwoods, with additional activities from the Southwoods yearbook also included. Athletic rosters and yearbook activities were used for Valley. The school could not supply activity rosters.

NOTE: The above two separate reports reached similar conclusions on the number of students participating and not participating at Valley.

April 4, 2002 – Senior Transcript Survey

In the fall, seniors fill out the sample form enclosed to list their 9th-12th grade participation. In the spring, the seniors are given another form and are asked to “list any honors or awards you have received this year.”

All the information supplied by the student is self-reported on the Valley transcript. The school’s activity sponsors and coaches do not check or validate the student’s information. The student’s parents do receive the transcript in the mail to read and correct.

The data collected by this process was reviewed to produce the enclosed Activity Information Chart. The chart’s 3-year average shows 85% of Valley seniors have participated in at least one activity during their four years of high school. A 3-year average of 12% of the

seniors self-reported no activities during their four years of high school. (3% of the forms were not returned)

NOTE: The Senior Transcript Survey does not necessarily disagree with the 1-02 Oral Survey and the 4-02 Participation Summary. The Oral Survey and the Participation Summary are a snapshot of participation in a given year while the Senior Transcript Survey covers any amount of participation during the senior's four-year high school experience.

April 11, 2002 – Athletic Facts

This paper details 8th -12th participation in both boys and girls sports for two school years. Girls soccer, girls softball, and boys baseball have not started yet this year, but this data should be available by the May 20th Design Down meeting and you will be updated at that time. The number of games or meets and the number of coaches for 9-12 is also included.

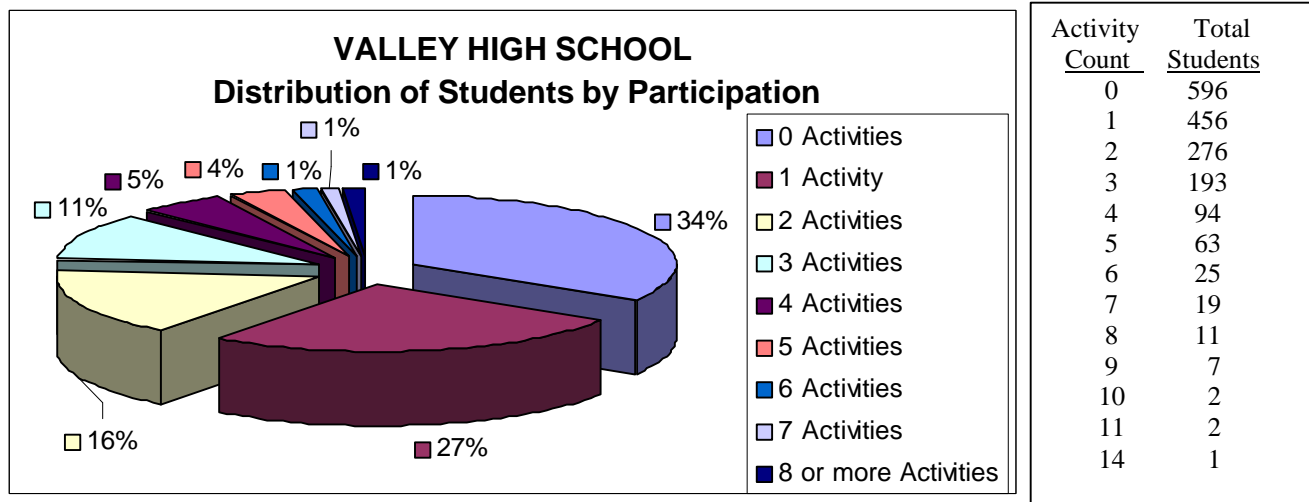

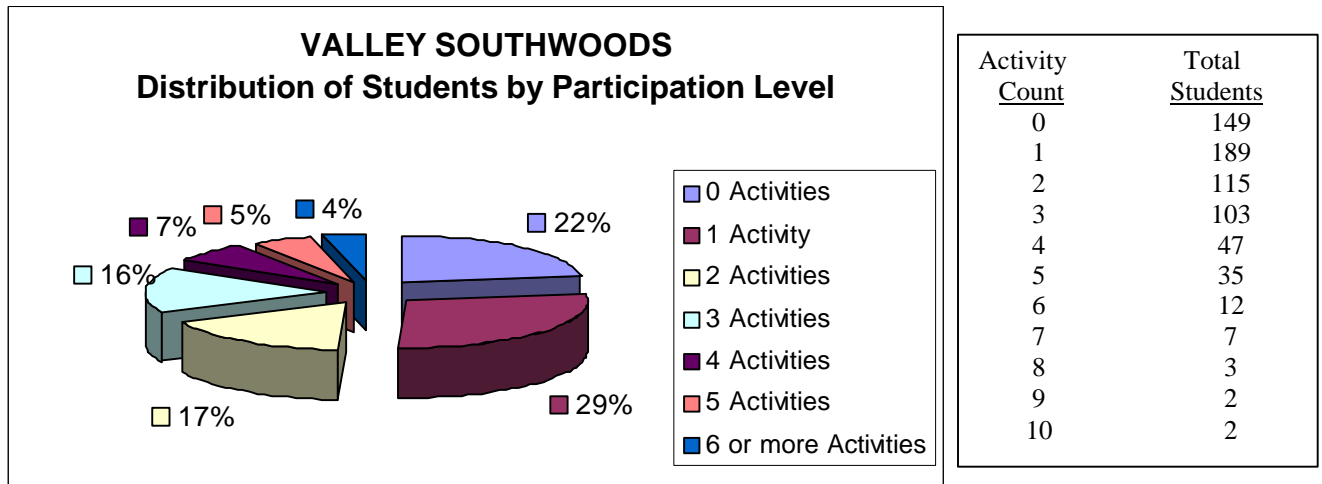
Valley Southwoods
