Volunteer Opportunities Descriptions

Benchmark Scoring: Help score benchmark tests.

Career Day – Speaker: Sign up if you would be willing to share your career with students on April 13, 2010.

Career Day – Volunteer: Help organize Career day on April 13, 2010.

Chaperone Dances: Collect money at the door, serve pop, supervise. Dances are from 5-7 p.m. on designated dates in school calendar.

Correct French papers: Self explanatory.

Correct Spanish papers: Self explanatory.

Drama Department: Assist drama teacher with the play and mimes in the areas of costumes, sets, break-a-leg breakfast and chaperones.

Fall Registration (2010-2011): Assist at registration days in directing parents through the registration process.

Field Trip Chaperone: Chaperone field trips. Each team takes 1-2 field trips a year.

Hospitality: Provide baked goods, drinks, food for parent teacher conferences and/or any special occasion

Magazine Sales: Verify order forms (mornings, one week in October) for Stilwell's ONLY fundraiser

Miscellaneous spot jobs: Willing to be contacted throughout the year as the need for volunteers arise. You would not be obligated or expected to be available each time you are contacted.

Piano Accompanist for band department: Daytime availability appreciated.

Team Teacher Assistant: Should require no more than 2 hours per week – schedule to be worked out by teacher and parent. Assisting teacher with his/her needs that do not require the teacher's expertise. This will allow the teachers to focus more on the job of teaching!
