

# West Des Moines Community Schools Summer School 2023

All high school classes are held at Walnut Creek Campus. Students may enroll in one class for make-up or original credit. ***ALL students must have their registration form signed by their counselor (for make-up credit) or administrator (for original credit) prior to starting summer school.*** Classes will be in session Monday through Friday, from June 19 through July 21. There will be no classes on Tuesday, July 4. The fee will be **\$225 per class** (WDM Students) or **\$275 per class** (students who do not attend WDM Schools). Priority will be given to West Des Moines students. Each class will be equivalent to one-semester credit. Each class will need to have a minimum of 12 students enrolled or the class will be canceled. **Once the class reaches 15 students, you will be placed on a waiting list or in a different section (if available).** The following classes are anticipated, dependent upon student interest:

**The final day to enroll will be Tuesday, June 20, 2023.** Full payment is due at the time of registration. If your son/daughter is signed up for a camp this summer, notify the coordinator in regards to the camp schedule **before** enrolling your student, as arrangements must be made, and approved, prior to the start of the class for making up time missed. If arrangements cannot be made, or if vacations are planned during this time, summer school may not be an option. **Refunds will not be offered once classes begin, including students who are dropped for attendance purposes.**

Note: If a class is closed at the time of your registration, you must contact your counselor regarding any alternative. A student may retake a course at Valley High School or Valley Southwoods (home school), in which case both grades will be shown on the transcript and the highest grade will be used in the grade point average. If the student chooses to re-take the course at Walnut Creek Campus both grades will be shown on the transcript and the higher grade will be used in the grade point average. Credit for a course can only be awarded once and a student cannot gain additional credit or lose credit by repeating a course where credit was already earned. Written application to repeat a course for a grade must be made with the counselor within the first 30 days of the semester in which the course is taken. Exceptions can only be made by the building administrator. While these are the expectations of the West Des Moines Community Schools, most districts have this same expectation. Forms will not be accepted without the counselor's or administrator's signature.
