May 18, 2021

1. Welcome and Introductions--Stephanie Horak, SCN President, called the meeting to order at 9:17 AM
2. Open Forum with Dr. Remy
 - a. WDMCS Online--Update was given on elementary and secondary online numbers with approximately 250 families choosing to enroll in online learning for 2021-2022 school year with most interest in the secondary levels. Numbers were not as high as expected. Looking to see if we can run any grade level sections. Do we have enough to offer classes and if so which ones and how many? Don't want to overload the in person students. Want to make a decision this week if we can run an online school. Some are still wanting online for Covid while some felt their daughter/son best learns online. Students outside the WDMCS system will not be able to enroll for next school year, but that is a possibility in the future. Delaying online open enrollment by one year will allow the district to market the option and will better align with open enrollment deadlines.
 - b. Staying with current mitigation strategies--CDC recommendations say to stay with current mitigation strategies through the end of the school year. Vaccinations are just starting for 12 and up. Don't know if it will go to younger students. Summer decisions and next school year decisions are still yet to be made. Dr. Remy took feedback from parents on masking next year.
 - i. Questions: Wonder about adults and students numbers who have been vaccinated? Wonder if based on numbers there might be different rules at different buildings? In general secondary parents were in favor of going unmasked because that age will have an opportunity to be vaccinated. Elementary parents expressed that their students won't be able to be vaccinated and there was support for continued masking at the elementary level.
 - c. Questions about volunteers this school year, changes as the year comes to an end, and use by buildings of parents in parent groups.

 - a. Projects at every building. Some have larger projects while others have smaller projects.
