- Fall Fundraiser: One main fundraiser of the year asking for monetary donations. Have students contact family members via text or email asking for donation. Donation is kept in house so no loss in revenue.

Q&A-

- Will start doing restaurant nights to raise some funds
- Grading Practices: 3 is 90% and 4 is 100%. 3 is always proficient. Grade percentage is secondary.
