Teacher Appreciation went well last week.

Teacher Appreciation Recognition where 400+ attendees were present and honored 120 retirees and milestone celebrations.

Indian Hills School Improvement Plan – Dr. Shane Christensen

- Goals were: 1 Academics – Meeting the goal for 7th grade and almost for 8th grade, Lots of interventions going on to help those students with D/F grades.
 - Making sure all students have access to learning. Subgroups are all growing.
- 2 attendance – Students on average are attending at least 93% of the time.
 - 81.5% not chronically absent, 18.42% of students Chronically absent.
- 3 behavior- PBIS works well to help students from major behavior issues – 96% of students have 2 or less office referrals.

Waiting for some ISASP testing scores to come in.

Last 3 Days of School:

- Tuesday after Memorial Day will run on a Wednesday schedule. Will have access club as well. 7th graders working on access clubs ideas for next year.
